

Longer Walks from Forest Glade

(Over 60 Minutes)

Walking to the Gliding Field (red walk)

Head past the swimming pool, up the lane and through the gateway then follow the track along the top of the Five Acre Field. Take the third turning on the left which is a wide forest track that ends in a parking area. Walk out of the parking area and turn right onto the road and then left along the track that starts at the top of the steep hill. This track takes you to the Gliding Field. On gliding days turn right at the metal gate

On gliding days turn right at the metal gate and follow the bridleway that goes along the bank to the far side of the field. Keep to the edge of the field and walk round to the clubhouse. Gliding usually takes place on Saturday, Sunday, Wednesday and Thursday unless there is a course or competition being held. Just take care and keep to the edges of the field at all times.

North Hill Café is open on gliding days and if there is a competition on, serving food from 9am to 3pm.

Sheldon Forest

Either walk or take your car to the start of the forest which is on the left on the road out to Honiton, just before the road dips down to Droughtwell Cottage. There is a nice walk right down through the forest but you have to return the same way.

Garnsey's Tower (blue walk)

Starting at the shop, walk over to the duck pond and then walk down the path along the outside of the ball games area fence. Go through the wood until you reach the wide track. Turn left and go right down this track until you reach the Y-junction. Turn right and follow the path out onto the road. Turn right. At the top of the hill go through the gate on the left into the forest. Continue along the track and eventually you should find the ruins of Garnsey's tower. Return to the road, turn left and walk along the road to the T-junction. Turn right and walk back to the park.
